



STATEMENT FROM THE UNITED STATES GOLF ASSOCIATION

The Rules of Amateur Status of the United States Golf Association provides that “playing for prize money” is a violation of those Rules.

Those who wish to protect their status as amateur golfers must sign this sheet, which will be forwarded to the USGA, no later than the first day of the tournament. The USGA will consider the entrant who does not sign the sheet to have forfeited his/her amateur status, and in no way or manner may he/she rescind that understanding with respect to accepting prize money. He/She also understands that, having signed this disclaimer, the sponsor shall not award to him/her any money prize and he/she agrees to that as a condition of entry.

Further, any player who has previously forfeited his/her amateur status, but wishes to be considered for reinstatement is also invited to sign this sheet. His/Her signature would be accepted as evidence that he/she did not violate the Rules by playing in this tournament for money. Players who wish to apply for reinstatement may obtain the necessary forms at www.usga.org.

Therefore, on the basis of the above interpretation and understanding, the undersigned declares that he/she shall not and will not accept prize money in the event that he/she is among the winners of the:
